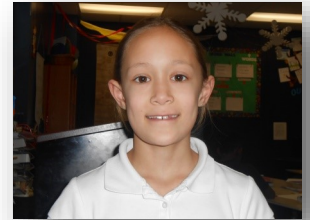

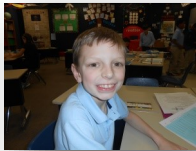
Science by Eli

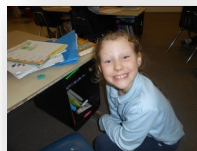
Grammar by Landon

On Monday we did a typing app for 10 or 20 minutes. Then we went on XL and created a survey. On Wednesday we did the same thing.



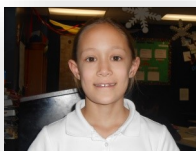
PE by Tegan
