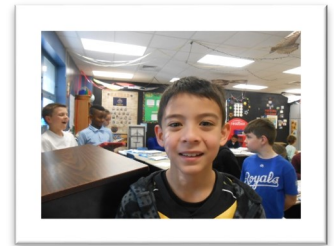

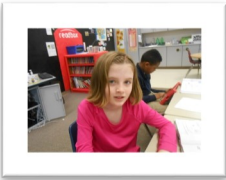

Chapel by Maddy

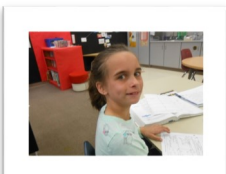
While the cross came in, we sang "Come Awake". We talked about how we get

blamed for some things and how Jesus did not deserve to die on the cross. We sang "I Will Rise". Last we did middle school awards and baptismal birthdays.



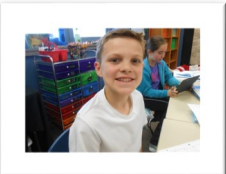
Religion by Nagango

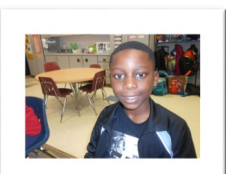
Math by Harmony

In math we did multiplied three numbers. Then we learned numbers like $5 \times 50 = 500$. Then we learned cm. Then we learned about kilograms and grams.



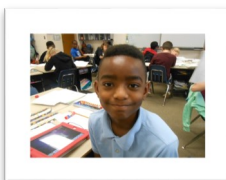
Reading by Zac

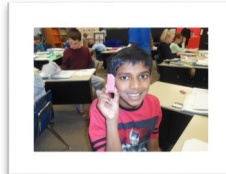
Social Studies by Nathan

This week we went on a virtual field trip to Jamestown.



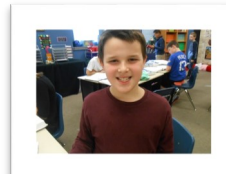
Science by Jason

We are doing a project by combining small machines called Rube Goldberg.



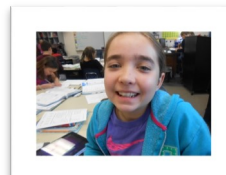
Grammar by Jashen

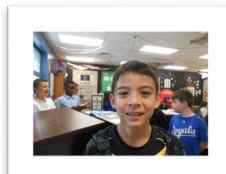
Computer by Daniel

On Monday we had no school and on Wednesday we did the Kansas State testing.



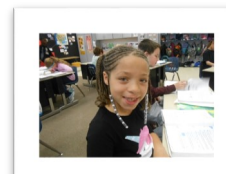
PE by Morgan
