On Monday we sang "Hymn of Promise" and "Now the Sun is Shining". On Wednesday we did the same thing.

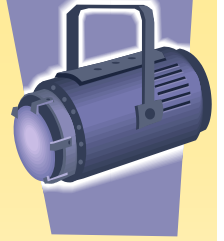
